

## **GAANN Fellowships in Mathematics at Dartmouth College**

*GAANN (Graduate Assistantships in Areas of National Need) Fellowships, funded by the U.S. Department of Education, are offered through the Dartmouth College mathematics department, and are available to applicants for the 2010-11 academic year.*

*These prestigious fellowships are intended to support students of achievement and potential who are U.S. citizens. If you are awarded a GAANN fellowship for your first year at Dartmouth, you will receive a stipend of up to \$30,000 (depending on financial need) in addition to health insurance and travel funding. After your first year, you will receive a Dartmouth fellowship, or other fellowship support.*

*We automatically consider all U.S. citizen applicants to our program for GAANN fellowship support, so you do not need to do anything extra to apply for a GAANN. If we select you as a fellowship recipient, we will ask you to submit a FAFSA in order to determine your financial need. Women and minorities are especially encouraged to apply.*
