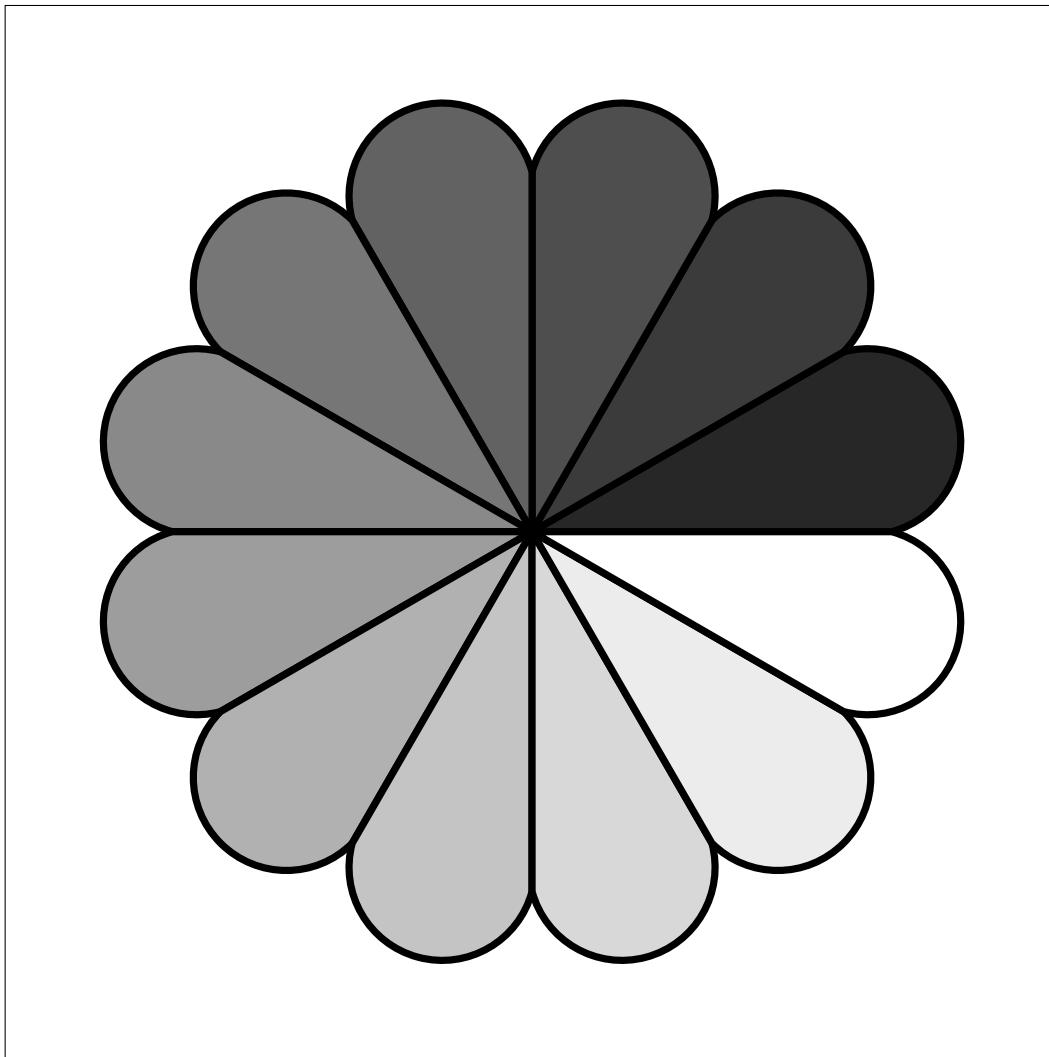
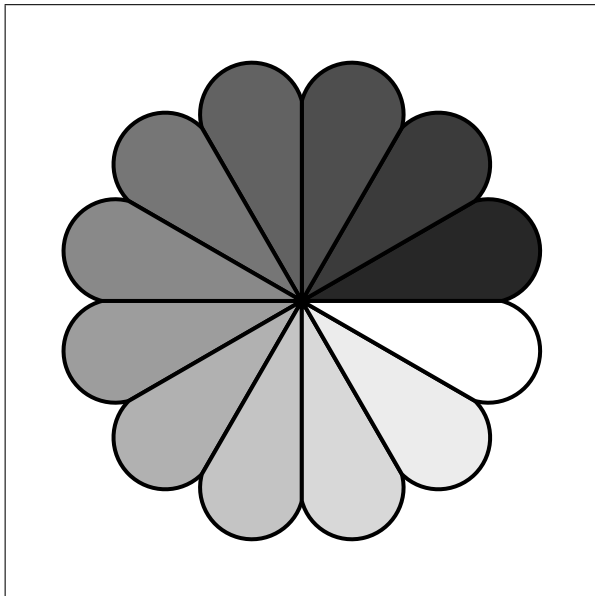


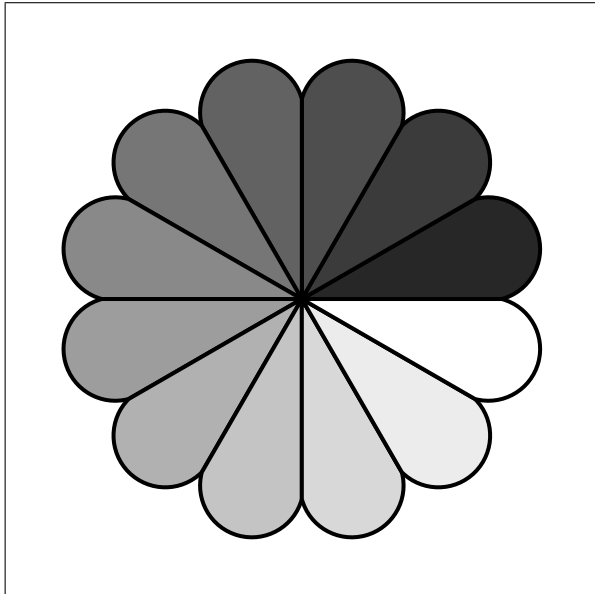
This is a test file. We start by scaling the figure to the width of the page. Note that for visibility, we have enclosed the postscript figure using a framed box (`\fbox` or `\framebox`) instead of a regular box (`\hbox`, `\mbox`, or `\makebox`).




Naturally, we can scale the figure to any size

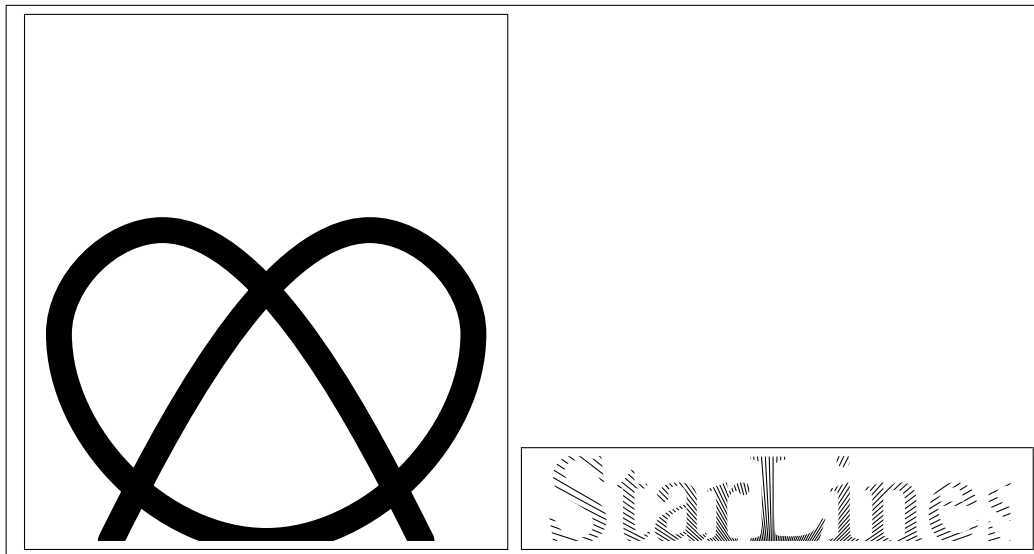


or using oldstyle commands like `\psfig`:

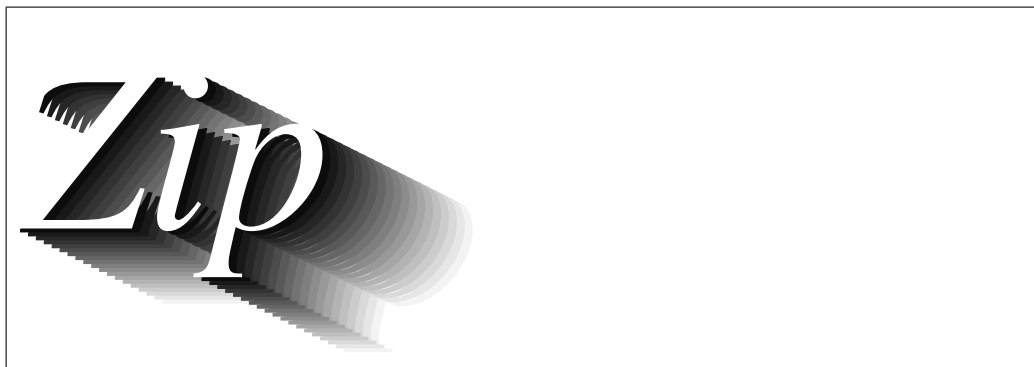


or even as a special character to appear in line .

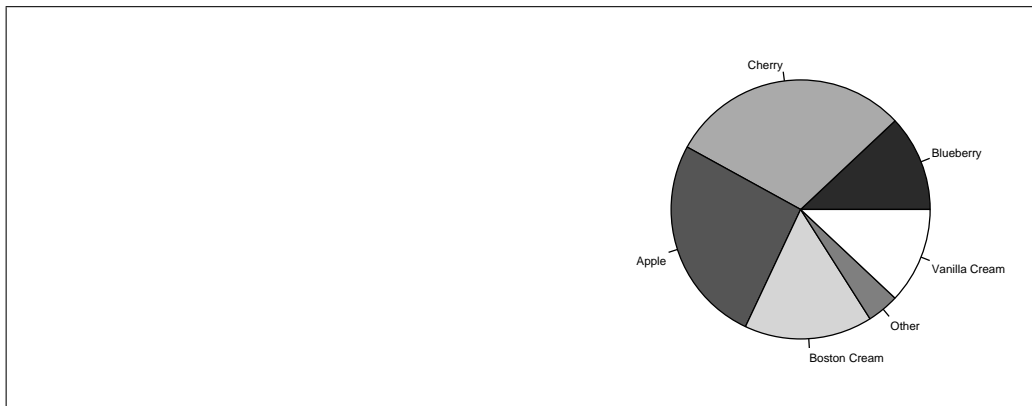
This figures can be arranged in the usual  $\text{\TeX}$  ways:



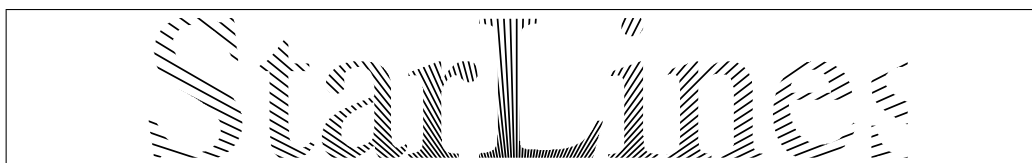
On the left,
